The painting on the cover of this issue is by Nat Whiton, Jr., author of the article on page 18 on the Oahu Railway and Land Company. Nat based his painting on a photo taken by Kent W. Cochrane in February, 1946. An Oahu Railway train, in-bound to Honolulu from Kahuku, has just rounded Kaena Point, and is heading south along the Waianae coast, past a natural formation known as Arch Rock. Number 70, one of the line's four Mikados, pulls a consist of boxcars loaded with sugar, gondolas loaded with sand, and loaded pineapple cars.
